# **Lunch Program**

The Provincial Lunch Program began this week. At Kingswood, we are very fortunate to have a cafeteria where all of the meals are prepared. The food is delivered to the students at the beginning of lunch, on time. All schools have roughly the same menu and the food providers have been given recipes to follow. So far the reviews from students have been mixed. While some students have told us it was the best meal ever others have said they did not like it. All of this is to be expected as the program is just being rolled out to thousands of children and children have definite opinions about what they like and don't like. Our regional centers are collecting feedback about how things are going and will make adjustments as needed. The next ordering window is from Friday Nov.1—Wednesday Nov. 6 at noon for the weeks of Nov. 11-15, Nov. 18-22. Reminder that there is no school on Nov. 11 and Nov. 22.

### **Important-School Hours**

Our school hours are 8:40am to 2:55pm. Students coming by bus arrive between 8:25am and 8:40am and students arriving by car should also come for the same time. We ask that all parents try to have children at school on time as instruction begins right away.

#### **Inclement Weather**

Did you know? HRCE takes great care when making the decision to alter the regular operations of schools and school buses in the event of severe or inclement weather.

It is HRCE's goal to communicate any changes to the regular operations of schools and/or buses as close to 6:00 a.m. as possible. A 6:00 a.m. announcement could be:

All schools are delayed in opening by two hours and bus pickups are delayed by two hours; or

All schools are open, but some or all busses are not operating for the day; or

Some schools (either individually or by family) are closed for the day; or

All schools are closed for the day.

If weather deteriorates, or is forecasted to worsen throughout the morning, **an 11:00 a.m. announcement could be:** 

Bussed students will be picked up two hours earlier than their regular dismissal time; and Walking students will be dismissed at their regularly scheduled lunch hour.
