As requested by the HRCE we participated in:

- Feedback survey from the Provincial SAC Conference
- HRCE School Advisory Council Feedback & Question Submission from our Regional Executive Director

At the school level this year:

- We reviewed and discussed student achievement data based on the school’s student success plan for literacy, math and wellbeing and student impact.
- We reviewed the KWE school Behaviour matrix and the Provincial Code of Conduct.

The SAC was active in contributing feedback for a multitude of anticipated changes for the 2026-2027 year. This included consultation on the following items:

- New construction of 2 playgrounds/landscaping to school grounds,
- Securing school photography contracts,
- Providing recommendations for new Principal hiring,
- Feedback regarding boundaries and re-zoning for areas nearby to the school.

The SAC worked collaboratively to explore options for budget expenditures throughout the year by:

- Conducting a survey of the KWE staff to better understand current needs within the school related to student learning and wellness within the mandate of the SAC bylaws.
- The annual allocated SAC budget was dedicated to purchasing much needed resources for teachers and students (including literacy and math resources) as well as subsidizing class field trips for students, benefiting all students and families within KWE.

- SAC Members engaged in consultation to provide feedback for the proposed playground re-construction anticipated for summer 2026.
- SAC and PSA members participated in the interviewing, selection and negotiation of a new 3-year photography contract, beginning in September 2026.

- The SAC Chair provided recommendations for hiring the new Principal starting in August 2026.
