| 4 | Reports | Principal's Report <br> 1. School update <br> Enrollment down slightly (808 students). Some families have moved out of area. There are 33 classrooms at Cap. Preprimary enrollment is stable at 73 students ( 4 classes in 4 big classrooms). The preprimaries have access to a gym and lots of outdoor play at parks. <br> Still having issues with bussing. Afternoons have improved, all busses now arrive at the school by $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}$. Mornings remain a challenge with bussing arriving late, between 8:45 am-8:55 am. The late arriving morning buses are having an impact on attendance, music, and physical education. It likely won't improve with the onset of bad weather or road construction. <br> 2. What's Happened <br> Terry Fox Run was held on September 28, 2022. The younger grades ran around the bus loop while the older grades ran around the field. |  |

The numbers of older kids who walk and bike have changed, many go Rocky Lake. <br> We acknowledged Dwarfism Awareness Day by wearing green. <br> Family Halloween Movie Night: Looks like the students may have voted for Hotel Transylvania. Standing room in gym is 874. The space is capped at 400 people. Over 200 tickets sold. \$2.50/ person. Some folks have paid for additional tickets that will be made available to families who might not be able to afford tickets. Movie is 1 h 30 mins. <br> Conference Day is a no school day for students.
